

PFIZER VACCINE

Consenters Information First and Second doses

- **Confirm name and dob and ethnicity.**
- Clarify whether this is a **first or second dose**. DO NOT give a third dose.
- Confirm date of previous dose- should **not be less than 3 weeks** before.
- Are you **over** the age of 16?
- If **first vaccine**- have you had an **immediate severe allergic reaction to different drugs** (e.g. oral, vaccine/injected drug or laxative) or to an **unknown substance** in the past? (Even if they have tolerated flu vaccine they need to be referred to allergy service).
- Did you get a **rash** after the first vaccine? Please describe it. (if it is **immediate onset** urticarial/hives- red raised bumps- will need conversation with prescriber)
- Have you had any other vaccine in the last seven days?
- Are you currently in a **COVID vaccine trial**? Can vaccinate under NP if they can show appropriate letter.
- Females of childbearing age: are you **pregnant**? (Pfizer can be given under NP following risk/benefit discussion, leaflet and documentation).
- Are you taking any blood thinners? **Please record DOACs and Warfarin on Pinnacle. Give vaccine as normal but apply pressure to site for 2 mins and advise re. bruising.**

You do not need to ask about fever or current COVID symptoms. This has been done at the front door.

Let them know that this is the **Pfizer** vaccine

Advised to wait for 15 minutes after vaccination for both 1st and 2nd doses.

Let them know we will call them for a second dose after a 10 week interval.
