Definition	Categories of adult abuse
<p>The safeguarding duties apply to an adult who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • has needs for care and support (whether or not the local authority is meeting any of those needs) and; • is experiencing, or at risk of, abuse or neglect; and • as a result of those care and support needs is unable to protect themselves from either the risk of, or the experience of abuse or neglect 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Physical ➤ Domestic Violence & Abuse ➤ Sexual ➤ Psychological ➤ Financial or Material ➤ Modern Slavery ➤ Discriminatory ➤ Organisational ➤ Neglect & Acts of Omission ➤ Self Neglect
<p>Remember to consider the needs of children that may be in the family home or have contact with the adult at risk; refer to the child contact sheet.</p>
